**PREMISES INSPECTION COMMITTEE DECISION REPORT  
Brampton Endoscopy Centre— Level 2

The Premises Inspection Committee (the Committee) has reviewed the Inspection-Assessment Summary of the Brampton Endoscopy Centre, dated October 31, 2016, following the onsite inspection-assessment by Dr. Clifford Ottaway, Dr. Matt Kurrek and Nurse Assessment Coordinator, Ms. Wendy Howe. This review took place on February 21, 2017.

Congratulations on the successful outcome of your inspection-assessment. The Committee was in agreement that Brampton Endoscopy Centre and staff are in keeping with the Out-of-Hospital Premises Standards. The Committee has issued the following outcome:

**Pass**

The Committee reminds you that Dr. Nadia Alam's ACLS certificate will expire on April 18, 2017. On that date, if it has not yet been renewed, she may not administer sedation. Her ACLS must include both a theory and a hands-on component to the course.

The Committee assumes that as Medical Director, you have already provided the individual physicians who were assessed with their individual assessment results for quality improvement purposes.

Now that your inspection-assessment is complete, please remember that anytime new physicians wish to start working at your premises, you must remind them that they are

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to satisfy the Regulation by notifying the College of their intent to work at the premises. Notifications must be completed on the College website ([www.cpso.on.ca](http://www.cpso.on.ca)) after logging into the member's account. After review of the notification, College staff will provide an email to the Member advising whether s/he may start at the premises. The member should provide a copy of this email to you to retain in your files. Physicians should also notify the College when they wish to be removed from your premises roster.

Thank you for your cooperation and I hope that you found your contact with the College through this process to be both interesting and educational. As per the current regulation, the College will contact you for the next stage of your inspection-assessment which will occur within 5 years.
