  - Blood thinner example: Warfarin (coumadin) must stop 5 days before!!

  - Continue regular blood pressure medication(s) with small sip (less than 20ml) of water.

4 HOURS BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT TIME.

- Continue all other regular medications unless you are diabetic.
- DIABETIC: since you will not be eating food on procedure day, you do not need to take medication.
- NO eating any seeds, grains, corn or leafy vegetables 3 days prior to the procedure.

#### WHAT IS A COLONOSCOPY?

A colonoscope is a long flexible tube that is about the thickness of a finger. It is inserted through the rectum into the large intestine (colon) allowing the doctor to carefully examine the lining of the colon. The causes of symptoms such as rectal bleeding or change in bowel habits/movement may be found by undergoing a colonoscopy. Through the colonoscope, the doctor can take a biopsy (a small tissue piece) and remove polyps for examination in the lab.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

- You will be sedated for this procedure and given medication to relieve pain and relax the colon.
- The procedure takes between 15 45 minutes. Delays may occur at times when providing quality care. Your patience is appreciated.
- After procedure, you will be taken to the recovery area for approximately 1 hour.

#### PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS: HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR PROCEDURE:

\*\*\*Drink 500ml to 1 liter of Gatorade/Powerade or water after both doses of laxatives\*\*\*

Purchase 8 tablets 5 mg each of DULCOLAX (Bisacodyl) AND 1 Box (2 sachets) of PICO-SALAX or PURGODAN from any pharmacy.

#### IF YOUR PROCEDURE APPOINTMENT IS BOOKED BETWEEN 8AM - 12:30PM

On the <u>day BEFORE</u> your procedure: Your <u>last solid meal should be a light breakfast (before 8 am).</u> You are required to remain <u>on a clear fluid diet until your procedure is over.</u>

### DO NOT EAT SOLID FOOD UNTIL YOU HAVE COME TO THE CLINIC AND FINISHED THE PROCEDURE!

- 4 PM take 4 Tablets of DULCOLAX. 6 PM drink one sachet of PICO-SALAX or PURGODAN. You can put this into a glass of cold water and drink it. Wait for half an hour and then drink at least 4-6 glasses of water over the next few hours. 9 PM drink second sachet of PICO-SALAX or PURGODAN & 4 DULCOLAX tablets.
- Drink at least 4-6 glasses of fluids after taking the laxatives.
- \*\*\*\*\*Stop drinking all clear fluids 4 hours prior to the test.
- Remember to remain on a <u>clear fluid diet</u> until your procedure is over.
- Cramps and diarrhea can be expected, GRAVOL can be taken if needed.

<u>CLEAR FLUID DIET:</u> includes water, apple juice, pineapple juice <u>without</u> chunks, black coffee and tea <u>without</u> milk or cream, <u>clear</u> soups and broths, Jell-O, popsicles, sprite, ginger ale, Gatorade or Powerade \*Gatorade or Powerade must be clear or yellow coloured!

\*\*\*(DO NOT CONSUME: red, purple or blue coloured fluids, no milk or cream and no orange juice).

On the <u>day BEFORE</u> your procedure: Your <u>last solid meal should be a light breakfast (before 12pm).</u> You are required to remain on a clear fluid diet until your procedure is over.

## DO NOT EAT SOLID FOOD UNTIL YOU HAVE COME TO THE CLINIC AND FINISHED THE PROCEDURE!

• 4 PM take 4 Tablets of DULCOLAX. 6 PM drink one sachet of PICO-SALAX or PURGODAN. You can put this into a glass of cold water and drink it. Wait for half an hour and then drink at least 4-6 glasses of water over the next few hours.

On the <u>day of your procedure</u>: 6 AM drink second sachet of PICO-SALAX or PURGODAN and 4 DULCOLAX tablets. Drink at least 4-6 glasses of fluids after this. Stop drinking fluids 4 hours prior to the test. Remember to remain on a clear fluid diet until your procedure is over. Cramps and diarrhea can be expected, GRAVOL can be taken if needed.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER THE PROCEDURE

- You may resume your usual diet (avoid greasy or spicy as the first meal) and activity. No drinking alcohol/smoking marijuana or operating a motor vehicle for 24 hours.
- The result of your biopsies (if taken) will be available in approximately 3-4 weeks.
